Safer Neighbourhood policing – “What does it mean and what do they do?” Safer Neighbourhood Teams (SNT’s) were introduced in every ward in London in April 2006. The idea is “Local officers, policing a local area and dealing with its’ residents and the problems that directly concern them” Every SNT is made up of 1 Sergeant, 2 Police Constables and 3 Community Support Officers.

FULLWELL CRIME FOR JANUARY 2010

Fullwell Ward suffered with 79 reported allegations of crime during January 2010.

There were 10 residential burglaries and 2 attempted burglaries where entry was NOT gained.

The favoured M.O. is still through the REAR garden either smashing or forcing the rear patio doors / windows

BURGULARS DISTURBED

Two (2) burglars were seen and confronted by Fullwell SN officers in ATHERTON ROAD. The males however assaulted the police officers and made off, dropping property as they left. Enquiries are in hand to identify and arrest these individuals.



NEW PUBLIC SET PRIORITIES

Fullwell Ward Panel came together on the 7th of January 2010. As a result the panel chose to close the Public Set Priorities of Fullwell Parade, Owen Waters House, Claire House and Repton Court.

STATE MANSIONS (and the surrounding area) and the TIPTREE ESTATE have now been adopted as the New FULLWELL SN priorities.

The above areas, including the offence of BURGLARY (across the ward) will be targeted by your local policing team, working with our partners to reduce Crime, ASB and as a result enhance the lives of the residents that live within Fullwell Ward.





SNOW PATROL

Through sleet, snow, rain and ice your local Safer Neighbourhoods Officers have been braving the elements, pounding the beat in order to reduce crime and in turn reduce the fear of crime within your area.

BURGLARY ARRESTS

During the month of January officers from Fullwell SNT arrested Two (2) people for residential burglary. They also assisted and were involved in the arrest of a further Two (2) people for residential burglary.
