Safer Neighbourhood policing – “What does it mean and what do they do?” Safer Neighbourhood Teams (SNT’s) were introduced in every ward in London in April 2006. The idea is “Local officers, policing a local area and dealing with its’ residents and the problems that directly concern them” Every SNT is made up of 1 Sergeant, 2 Police Constables and 3 Community Support Officers.

FULLWELL CRIME FOR DECEMBER 2009

Fullwell Ward suffered with 61 Crimes during the month of December 2009, a reduction on 36 crimes on December 2008.

The Ward suffered 11 Burglaries – the favoured method of entry being via the rear of the house and either smashing or forcing open the rear kitchen or patio door.

BE VIGILANT

Burglars usually continue to break into houses in January as they know there will be NEW property in the address worth nicking.

Please be vigilant, lock all doors and windows, remove tools from gardens and REPORT all suspicious activity.



CLAMPDOWN ON CANNABIS

During the month of December 2009 Fullwell SNT officers charged Two (2) local residents with cannabis related crimes.

One (1) was charged with the Production/Cultivation of Cannabis.

The other was charged with Possession of Herbal Cannabis with intent to supply.

This proactive and positive approach towards cannabis by your Safer, Neighbourhood Policing Team sends out a clear message that the possession / use / sale of drugs within FULLWELL ward will NOT be tolerated
