## Public Set Priorities

We listen to the concerns of the community and our priorities are set by local people who sit on a neighbourhood panel.

You said the following priorities were important to you:

- **Burglary** (Ward Wide)
- **Vehicle Crime** (Ward Wide)
- **Anti Social Behaviour** (Wedmore Ave and associated area)

## Burglary.

During the month of April 2011 Fullwell ward suffered with a total of **6** residential burglaries, **5** where persons forced entry, and **1** where the occupant was distracted.

SNT officers are continuing with visible and plain clothes Burglary patrols on foot and it is hoped that as a result of this we have displaced those considering offending within the Fullwell ward.

Please continue to report all suspicious activity as this will assist us in prioritising our response and subsequent patrols.

## Theft of / Theft from Motor Vehicle.

During the month of April there were **4** vehicles stolen and **2** theft from vehicles allegations within Fullwell ward. **6** Vehicles were subject to criminal damage.

Vehicle registration plates are still being stolen from vehicles – please contact us on the number shown if you require a set of **FREE** “anti-theft” screws.

Through the hard work of your local SNT and various locally held initiatives incidents of motor vehicles being broken into have been dramatically reduced. To help us to maintain this current trend please make sure your vehicle is locked, all your windows are

closed and any items of value are removed completely or from view.

## A.S.B - Wedmore Ave and immediate vicinity.

SN officers are continuing with their patrols (at varying times) in and around Wedmore Avenue in order to deal with the problem of Anti Social Behaviour.

We are at present liaising with the Local Authority in relation to some suggested changes to the local environment. Police feel that these small changes and enhancements will improve the area and at the same time will help reduce instances of crime.

Claybury Park and Woods are patrolled by The Local Authority Parks Police and Fairlop Safer Neighbourhood Policing Team who are responsible for this area.
